



Board Notes

Regular Board Meeting March 8, 2020

Continued discussion regarding the maintenance of the parking lot was held. With the better weather, paving companies are beginning to inspect and quote for parking lots. In order to help fundraise for this cost, the Board approved the compilation and sale of a church cookbook.

As C.E. and Children's Director, Irene Buettner requested to expand the AWANA program to include youth older than those who are currently reached. As a number of kids would be aging out within the next year, the Board happily agreed to this expansion to continue to encourage the kids' attendance.

A gardening and/or canning ministry has been proposed. The Board will plan to meet with those interested in leading this ministry next month before a decision is made.

A potential response to a large outbreak of the Coronavirus was discussed. If Erie County begins reporting cases, the Board will make a decision regarding cancelling church as a preventative measure.

Diane Hall and Lynette Straite presented that we will be having a missions conference with the Volstads the weekend of April 4 and 5. After discussion it was decided to hold all events on Sunday April 5 due to the Easter Egg Hunt on April 4.
