URGENT PRAYER REQUEST ~ Persecuted Church

Please pray for Alliance workers and national believers around the world as repression of Christianity is on the rise in many areas. Specifically, pray for God's intervention to keep the doors open for the good news to be proclaimed and for government authorities in these nations to reverse their position on religious freedom. Intercede also that U.S. churches will learn to focus on strengthening believers in these end times through developing strong disciples of Jesus.

Burkina Faso

Intercede for two church plants starting this month in Bobo-Dioulasso. Pray specifically for strong lay leadership for these congregations and that the Lord will prepare hearts for the gospel in their neighborhoods.

Pray for a lay-leader training seminar this week. Ask for a good response to this training, especially among those who work in areas where many are coming to Christ.

Faith Promise Pledge Cards

In today's bulletin you will find a faith promise pledge card for the Great Commission Fund (GCF).

What is a faith promise? It is a pledge to give a certain amount to the GCF in the coming year. It is a *faith* promise because it is trusting that God will provide the amount that you promise.

What is the Great Commission Fund? The GCF is the Christian and Missionary Alliance's account that supports all their missionaries. By keeping one common fund, the denomination is able to send out missionaries who do not need to be concerned with raising their own support. The missionaries are able to spend more time fulfilling their calling of spreading the gospel around the world.

How long is my faith promise for? The pledge year for our church runs through September 30, 2019.

I don't want others to know how much I am giving. Can I do it anonymously? A faith promise is truly between you and God. You are more than welcome to pledge anonymously, simply do not include your name on the pledge card. The reason names are collected is so that the mission's treasurer can keep track of the balance on your pledge in case you lose track.

When are pledges due? Cards should be placed in the offering today or next Sunday.
