### Urgent Alliance Prayer Request

Four years ago, The Alliance requested prayer for Jerry Krause, a missionary pilot who had partnered with C&MA international workers in Africa. He was kidnapped on April 7, 2013. Although the South African Civil Aviation Authority declared that Jerry's plane had crashed and he was dead, his family received reports that he was recently seen alive in Africa and that the U.S. government knows his location. Pray for official authorization to be given to the Department of Defense to secure Jerry's freedom and reunite him with his family. Intercede as well for Jerry's protection, health, and strength.
