Urgent Prayer Request

Despite the catastrophic devastation the Bahamas suffered in the wake of Hurricane Dorian, Alliance churches in Nassau were spared from the brunt of the slow-moving storm, which is expected to bear down on Florida, Georgia, and the Carolinas late Tuesday and early Wednesday. Please pray for the safety of the Alliance family in the broad path of this potentially devastating storm. CAMA is already working with the Alliance Southeast District to prepare for Dorian's landfall and help coordinate any efforts needed in the aftermath. Pray for Tom Olney of the Palm Coast Bible Church, who has been designated as the district point person to establish and maintain a communications network between Florida churches during and after the storm. Pray also for those in the Bahamas who have suffered devastation and that the Church will rise to this opportunity to provide tangible help and hope in the months ahead.
